## **6-Year Graduation Rates**


- Six-year graduation rates for first-time full-time degree-seeking undergraduates are displayed in Table 1 and Figure 1.
- In Fall 2017, 203 first-time full-time degree-seeking undergraduates enrolled at Otis College and 61% of these students graduated within 6 years (i.e., by August 31, 2023).

## First-to-Second Year Retention Rates


- First-to-second year retention rates of first-time full-time degree-seeking undergraduates are shown in Table 2 and Figure 2.
- In Fall 2022, 314 first-time full-time degree-seeking undergraduate students enrolled and one year later, in Fall 2023, 73% of these students re-enrolled.
