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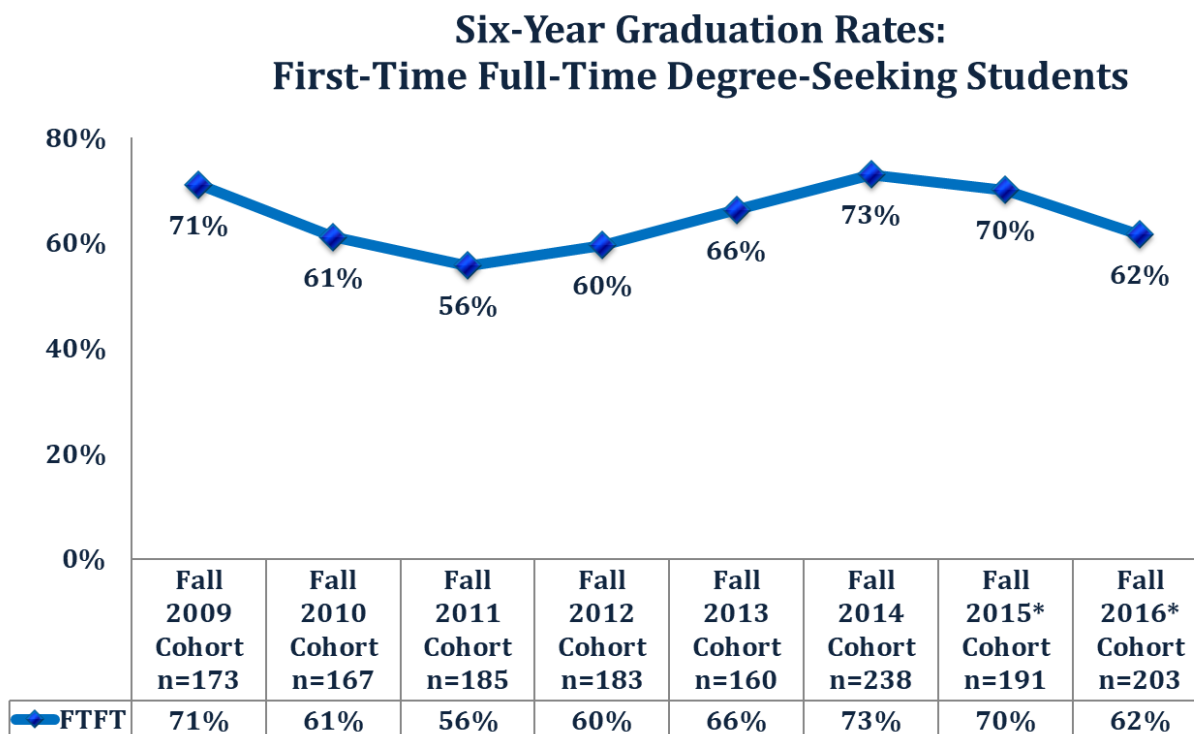
6-Year Graduation Rates

- ◆ Six-year graduation rates for first-time full-time degree-seeking undergraduates are displayed in Table 1 and Figure 1.
- ◆ In Fall 2015, 191 first-time full-time degree-seeking undergraduates enrolled at Otis College and 70% of these students graduated within 6 years (i.e., by August 31, 2021).

^b Time horizon impacted by COVID-19 pandemic

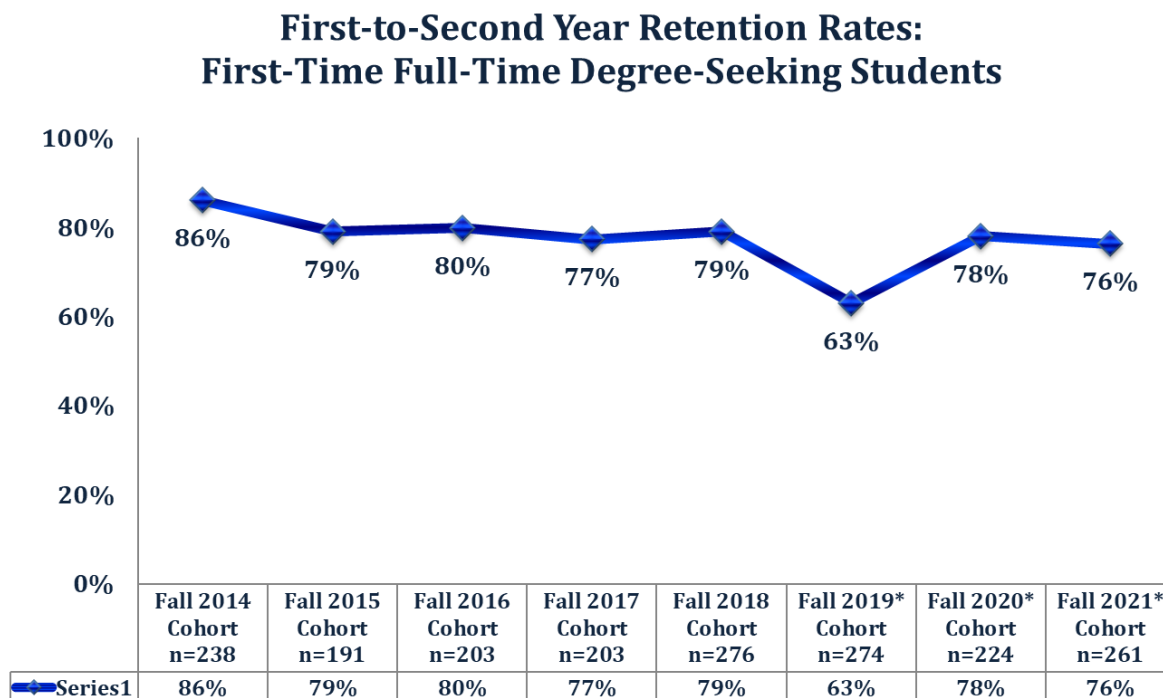
First-to-Second Year Retention Rates

- ◆ First-to-second year retention rates of first-time full-time degree-seeking undergraduates are shown in Table 2 and Figure 2.
- ◆ In Fall 2021, 261 first-time full-time degree-seeking undergraduate students enrolled and one year later, in Fall 2022, 76% of these students re-enrolled.
