

SECTION I: Transferable Foundation (FNDD) Studio Courses

Otis College recommends sophomore transfer students match the Foundation Studio Curriculum as closely as possible. However, **we generally accept 18 credits of art or design studio courses**. Students must show a portfolio that demonstrates they are able to bypass the Foundation Year. *College of Marin courses that are an ideal match to Otis College's first-year Foundation Program are listed in the chart below. **NOTE:** Otis requires 18 semester units for Foundation Studio; recommended College of Marin courses total 20 semester units as each course is 4 units.*
