

# Creative Writing Minor



The Creative Writing minor offers art and design students an opportunity to give voice and shape to their creativity through a variety of written expressive forms. The minor provides guidance and support to students in a structured environment to develop their writing, and an exciting way to explore their personal visions through workshops and lectures.

## **Eligibility**

The Creative Writing minor is open to students majoring in Architecture/Landscape/Interiors, Communication Arts, Digital Media and Fine Arts. Because of their major curricular requirements Fashion Design, Product Design and Toy Design majors will only be approved to enroll on a case-by-case basis. Students must be on track in their major and in good academic standing, with no more than 6 credits behind and a cumulative GPA of 2.0.
