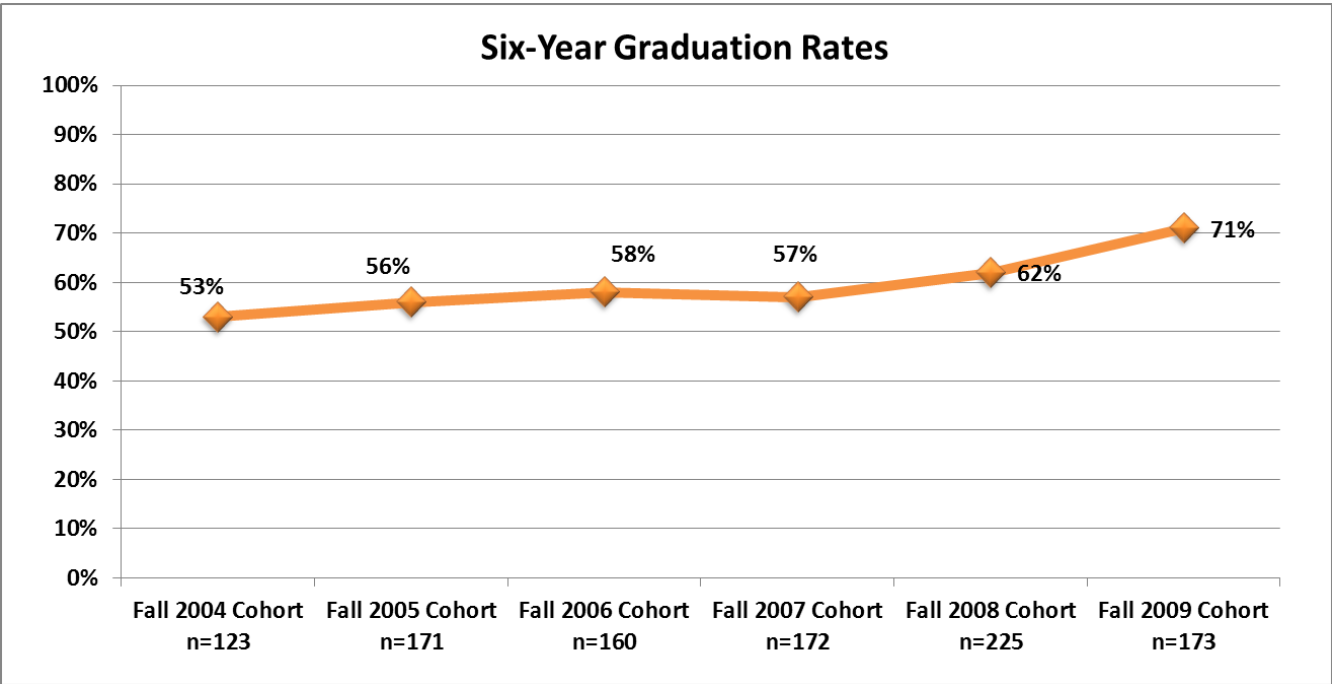

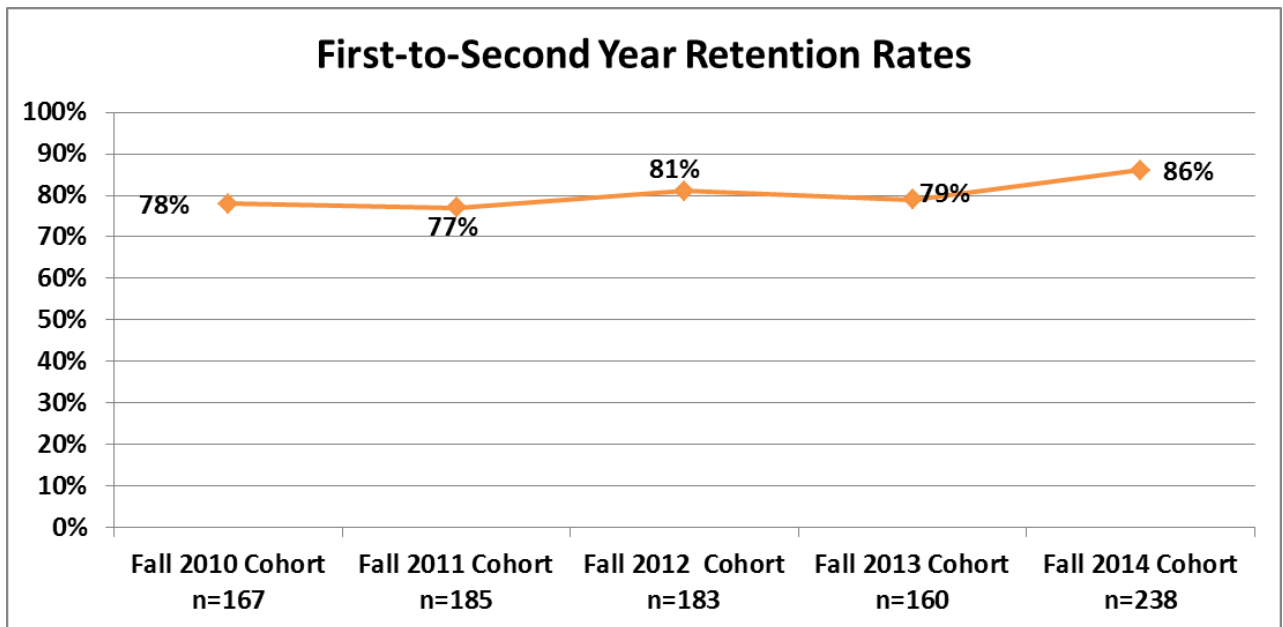
- ◆ Six year graduation rates of first-time, full-time, degree-seeking undergraduates.
- ◆ For example: In Fall 2004, 123 first-time, full-time, degree-seeking, undergraduate students entered and 53% of these students graduated within 6 years (i.e., by August 31, 2010).

First-to-Second Year Retention Rates

Fall 2011 Cohort	185	77%
Fall 2012 Cohort	183	81%
Fall 2013 Cohort	160	79%
Fall 2014 Cohort	238	86%

- ◆ First-to-second year retention rates of first-time, degree-seeking undergraduates.
- ◆ For example: In Fall 2010, 167 first-time, degree-seeking undergraduate students entered and one year later (i.e., Fall 2011), 78% of these students were still enrolled.
