



Trusting Your Instincts: Decisive Oil Painting

Materials List

Materials for the first class are as follows:

- 3 painting supports, 9x11in or 11x14in
These can be gesso board, canvas board (oil primed preferably) or a heavy watercolor paper sized in advance of class with PVA size. It is important that whatever the painting surface, that it not be overly absorbent. We will go over this in class.

Oil colors:

- Ivory Black
- Titanium White
- Ultramarine Blue
- Red Oxide (or Venetian Red)

Bristle brushes:

- Filbert or flat – 1½ inch, 1 inch, ½ inch
- One large “value” bristle brush 2 inch

White palette

Palette knife

Odorless mineral spirits

1 box of Kleenex

A roll of paper towels

A few plastic bags

Containers for mineral spirits

Plain masking tape

Important: A hard somewhat heavy board about 16 x20 or 20x30in. Masonite, cardboard, hardboard, etc.
